Karen has been serving in Vogan, Togo for 6 years. She is partnering with the Christian Mission for the Community Development of Togo, started by a local pastor and his wife. Nearly 81.2% of Togo's rural population lives under the global poverty line. This makes Togo one of the world's poorest countries. The needs are tremendous: high levels of malnutrition, maternal death, malaria and infectious diseases due to lack of hygiene, and yet the government is doing almost nothing to address these issues.
